

RULES of PLAY for Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation Catch the ACE

Lottery License #11878

The Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation Catch the Ace lottery is a progressive raffle; a multiple-draw game in which participants purchase tickets for a weekly chance to win, and is managed and instituted by members of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation.

TICKETS:

- Tickets are \$5.00 each
- Participants must be at least 18 years of age – proof of age may be required at ticket outlets
- Tickets can be purchased with CASH only at designated locations. Tickets may be purchased by credit card at the CMH Foundation office.
- Ticket DRAW time and LOCATION will be identified on the TICKET and posted where tickets are sold
- Tickets are in TWO parts; A) the ticket itself (retained by the purchaser) and the B) Draw Ticket Stub (Retained by the Sales Agent)
 - Both parts (A and B) of the ticket should be completed. Part A includes the Valid Envelope Number entered by the purchaser. Part B includes the NAME and PHONE NUMBER of the purchaser and the ENVELOPE number chosen by the purchaser.
 - The ticket purchaser must enter a VALID Envelope number from the list of available numbers remaining in play published for that week's draw.
 - The ticket purchaser will be responsible to ensure the ticket and stubs are FILLED OUT CORRECTLY and LEGIBLY.

- Each weekly ticket batch will be unique from draw to draw (in number sequence, colouring of tickets and weekly draw number). There will be NO duplication of ticket numbers for all draws under the license. Tickets will be purchased and the ticket numbers will be logged for each draw and cross referenced prior to selling tickets.

- Tickets will be sold on a weekly basis starting Thursdays at the end of the current draw and terminating the next week on Thursday evening at 5:00 p.m. at the draw location.

- Tickets will be sold on a weekly basis at designated locations until 12:00 p.m. on the day of the draw. Tickets will be available for purchase at the Draw Location from 4:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m. with the draw commencing at 6:00 p.m.

- The tickets are ONLY eligible and valid for the draw in which they were purchased.

- The Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation reserves the right to limit the number of tickets sold to an individual or group of people per weekly draw.
- The Catch the Ace Draw sales will continue until the ACE of SPADES has been drawn. Once that takes place, the CURRENT Catch the Ace Draw will end.

GROUP PLAY

- Group play is allowed and encouraged.
- Group play is considered to be more than two individuals per raffle ticket.
- The person in charge of the group of players (the captain) will print their first name and last name on the ticket followed by the word “captain” or “capn” in brackets after their last name.
- The name of the group should be printed on the back of the ticket.
- Any resulting winnings will be paid to the captain of the group. The designated group play captain shall be the person responsible for the fair and equitable distribution of the prize money among the group play members.

PRIZE ALLOCATIONS:

Prize money allocations will be as follows:

- o Twenty percent (20%) of the weekly sales will go directly to the winner of the ticket drawn
- o Thirty percent (30%) of the weekly sales will be added to the PROGRESSIVE PRIZE Jackpot
- o Fifty percent (50%) of the weekly sales will be allocated to the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation
- Should the winner of the ticket chosen have selected the envelope containing the ACE of SPADES, the winner will be awarded:
 - o The Twenty percent (20%) of the weekly sales
 - o The total rising Progressive Jackpot of monies including the Thirty percent (30%) of the proceeds from the sale of the tickets in the current weekly draw.
- If in the event, an invalid envelope number was identified on the winning ticket stub, the next LOWEST envelope number to the envelope number identified on the winning ticket would be determined as the SELECTED ENVELOPE. If the next lowest number is not available, then the next closest envelope will be determined as the SELECTED ENVELOPE

DRAW BOARD PREPARATION:

- A minimum of two (2) Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation bona fide members must participate in the Draw Board preparation.
- Before commencing the lottery ticket sales, a deck of fifty-two (52) playing cards will be randomly shuffled and left face down.

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- Without being revealed, each of the playing cards will be placed in identical, envelopes that are sealed.
- The envelopes will then be shuffled.
- The envelopes will then be given a singular number from one (1) to fifty-two (52)
- The envelopes will be placed in numerical order in a LOCKED display case that will act as the DRAW BOARD.
- The DRAW BOARD will always be under the care of a Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation bona fide member.

TICKET DRAWS

- Weekly ticket draws will be CONDUCTED and MANAGED by a minimum of two (2) bona fide members of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation
- One (1) bona fide member of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation will announce the draw details, and then proceed to DRAW the winning ticket from the Raffle drum, announces the weekly winner from the drawn ticket and announce the envelope number chosen.

Immediately prior to each draw the following will be announced to those present:

- The number of the current weekly Draw
- The Ticket Sales of the current weekly Draw
- The Draw Prize (Twenty Percent (20%) of the weekly sales)
- The current Progressive Jackpot amount (including the Thirty percent (30%) from the weekly sales for the current draw)
- Cumulative proceeds to the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation.
- The other bona fide member of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation will; shake the draw drum to mix the tickets, select a ticket, open the locked draw board, remove the chosen envelope, lock the draw board, open the sealed envelope, and remove, reveal and announce the card from within the chosen envelope, and destroy the revealed card. This member will also call the number on the winning ticket to inform the winner of the prize amount and how to claim their prize.
- Those two (2) bona fide members who conduct and manage the draw MUST NOT HAVE A TICKET IN THE DRAW IN THEIR NAME or have someone purchase a ticket for them in their name for that weekly draw. This restriction will also apply to members of the CMH Foundation Board of Directors, and the Chief Executive Officer and the Chief Financial Officer of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital.
- The bona fide member drawing the winning ticket MUST NOT have purchased, or have had someone purchase a ticket for them in their name for that weekly draw.

- Other than those listed above, all other people assisting in the weekly draw, including a bona fide members of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation who are NOT conducting/managing the draw, will be eligible to have a ticket in the draw in their name.
- Ticket draws will take place at 6 p.m. every Thursday starting on Thursday April 2, 2020. It is guaranteed that the draw will not take place prior to this time. However, depending on a number of factors, it may take place after this time. Organizers will do their best to keep as close to 6:00 p.m. as possible, though delays are possible and at times inevitable. Should there be a need to cancel a regularly scheduled ticket draw; potential participants will be notified on our website www.givetocmh.ca and through our Facebook page Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation (**cmhospitalfoundation**).
- See Appendix “A” for the complete Draw schedule including location
- At 6:00 p.m. one (1) ticket will be randomly drawn from all tickets sold in the week leading up to the current draw. The name of the winning ticket holder will be announced along with the envelope number chosen.
- The winning ticket holder will receive the weekly prize amounting to twenty percent (20%) of the weekly draw ticket sales.
- The draw board will be unlocked and the envelope number chosen on the winning ticket will be removed from the draw board and the draw board will be relocked.
- The envelope with the chosen number shown on the winning ticket will be opened and the card contained within revealed, announced, and after which, that card is destroyed.
- If the ACE of SPADES is selected, in addition to winning the prize from the draw, the ticket purchaser will win the progressive jackpot.
- The ticket purchaser drawn does NOT have to be in attendance to win.

CARD DRAW WEEK 52

- If the lottery proceeds until week 52, that is, when there is just one unopened envelope remaining, there is no need for anyone to choose an envelope number as this remaining envelope will naturally contain the ace of spades. At that last weekly draw the winning ticket holder will receive the weekly prize of 20% of the weekly ticket sales in addition to the jackpot increase of 30% of weekly sales combined with the jackpot prize amount to date. In other words, winner takes all.

VIDEO TAPING

- All draws will be video recorded and available to the licensing authority (Alcohol & Gaming Commission of Ontario) upon request. The video recording will be in high definition at least 720p in a well-lit environment with unobstructed views of all raffle activities including:
 - o Selection of the winning draw ticket
 - o Selection of the envelope by the bearer on the winning ticket
 - o Reveal of the playing card in the selected envelope
 - o Destruction of the playing card
- All video recordings will be maintained for at least thirty (30) calendar days from the draw date, after which time they may be deleted or destroyed as determined by the Alcohol and Gaming Commission Guide for the raffle.
- Any winning ticket holder who is paid a prize agrees to grant to the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation an irrevocable right to publish through all types of media broadcasting, including the internet for purposes of promoting the win, their full name, hometown and photograph without any claim for broadcasting, printing or other rights. The winning ticket holder who is paid a prize also gives the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation the right to publish any additional information that they voluntarily provide. The winning ticket holder shall have no claim against the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation for invasion of privacy or any other grounds by reason of the publication or broadcasting their name, hometown or photograph or information voluntarily provided by the winner.

FORCE MAJEURE

- If it is deemed that at any point during the Lottery, the bona fide members who are conducting and managing the draw cannot ensure the safety of participants, staff, volunteers and the public through every reasonable measure has been taken, those bona fide members will conclude the current lottery on the following Thursday.

After Weekly Draw Details

- Tickets are valid only for the draw for which they are purchased. Once the draw is completed, the non-winning tickets are removed from the raffle drum. A new series of tickets will be sold for the next draw.
- After each draw that does NOT produce the ACE of SPADES, the remaining envelopes with the cards in them will be kept in a secure location.
- At the conclusion of each draw, all non-winning tickets will be removed from the drum, and (together with all remaining unsold tickets for that draw) retained and destroyed after thirty (30) days.
- At the conclusion of each draw, the WEEKLY Winner will be contacted by a bona fide member of the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation and the WEEKLY Winner will be announced

publically on our FACEBOOK Page; Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation and on our website www.givetocmh.ca.

- All weekly winners along with associated weekly prize allocations and Progressive Jackpot will be available to the public on our FACEBOOK Page; Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation and on our website www.givetocmh.ca
- Winning tickets will remain on file in accordance with the requirements of the raffle license.
- A record will be kept of all draws, including the sequence of ticket numbers and other characteristics of tickets in play (colour of tickets, weekly identifiers etc.)
- The Rules of Play will be made available to all participants through our website www.givetocmh.ca and at the draw venue.

Proceeds

- All funds raised, less allowable expenses, will support the purchase of capital and medical equipment for the Campbellford Memorial Hospital through the registered charity operating in Trent Hills, Ontario; the Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation
